How to Resolve Conflict God's Way By Kyle Rye

Conflict is inevitable but conflict itself is not something that should frighten us. God knew conflict existed, and, therefore, He provided us with everything we need to know about handling it. In Matthew 18:15-17 Jesus identified a three-step process for handling conflict that involves sin. It is a process that hinges on the first step, which says, "If your brother sins, go and show him his fault in private; if he listens to you, you have won your brother." All too often this step is ignored in favor of taking the matter to the elders or avoiding the situation altogether. But if we're going to handle conflict God's way then we have to be willing to engage in private confrontation. Here are ten steps for how to engage in one on one confrontation.

1. Prepare with prayer (Matthew 5:44).

2. Get the Facts (Exodus 20:16; Proverbs 20:19). Know the truth before you approach the individual. Don't be guilty of false accusations.

3. Examine yourself (Matthew 7:3-5). Make sure you're not guilty of living in sin before you confront someone who is.

4. Don't wait (Ephesians 4:26; Matthew 5:23-24). In other words, don't let the emotions fester longer than is necessary to complete the previous steps.

5. Understand the goal of the confrontation – to win back your brother or sister (Matthew 18:5). Do not pursue any other agendas.

6. Meet in person. Jesus instructs us to "go" to the person (Matthew 18:15). Don't use texts, emails, or phone calls because they are impersonal and prevent you from hearing tone or seeing body language.

7. Affirm the relationship. Make sure the individual knows that you care about him or her (Matthew 22:39; 1 John 4:20).

8. Approach honestly but lovingly (Ephesians 4:15).

9. Be willing to listen (Proverbs 18:13; James 1:19).

10. Be prepared to forgive (Matthew 18:21-35).
